

STANDING ORDER 6
CODE OF CONDUCT – TPI FEDERATION

I. A Director:

- a. Must act honestly, in good faith and in the best interests of the Federation.
- b. Has a duty to use due care and diligence in fulfilling the functions of office and exercising the powers attached to that office.
- c. Must use the powers of office for a proper purpose.
- d. Must recognise that the primary responsibility is to the Federation, but should, where appropriate, have regard to the interests of all TPIs.
- e. Must not make improper use of information acquired in the course of the exercise of his duties unless such disclosure has been authorised by the Board or is required at law. Such information remains the property of the Federation.
- f. Must not take improper advantage of the position of Director.
- g. Must not allow personal interests, or interests of any TPI Association or associated person, to conflict with the interests of the Federation.
- h. Has an obligation to be independent in judgement and actions and to take all reasonable steps to be satisfied as to the soundness of all decisions taken by the Directors.
- i. Should not engage in conduct likely to bring discredit upon the Federation.
- j. Has an obligation at all times to comply with the spirit as well as the letter of the law and with the principles of this Code.
- k. Who disrupts/interrupts any Meeting will get one warning from the Chairman, should he continue to disrupt/interrupt he will be required to withdraw from the meeting for the remainder of the day. Such person may direct his proxy to another Director.
